Our first qualifications-based project was the **79th Avenue Park and Ride Upgrade CMAR** (photo below) for the City of Phoenix. This project was constructed in 2002 and included the installation of 350 prefabricated parking shade canopies, construction of a security substation, and installation of new video surveillance systems.

## **Spring Cleaning and Rehabilitation**



#### Central Mesa Sewer Interceptor Rehabilitation CMAR

Achen-Gardner is working with specialty subcontractors to rehabilitate more than 10,000 LF of 30" to 48" sewer lines using Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) and 41 manholes using various methods, such as coatings, PVC repair, and new frame and covers. Our past experience on similar projects and collaboration with the City of Mesa is providing best value as we prioritize the immediate rehabilitation needs and contribute to the long-term resilience and sustainability of the City's wastewater system. **Visit our website for more project information and photos.**

#### Detroit Basin/Gazelle Meadows Park Storm System and Associated Improvements CMAR

We are currently installing more than 7,000 LF of large diameter storm drain, 36 catch basins, and 34 manholes in a residential area of Detroit Basin and Gazelle Meadows Park. This neighborhood has had flooding issues for years and we are proud to be working with the City of Chandler and Entellus (design engineer) to improve storm drain conditions as well as other, much-needed water and sewer infrastructure.
